

Everyday Homeopathy: *The Essentials*

Course Overview

Everyday Homeopathy is a practical, foundational course designed to introduce students to the principles, philosophy, and clinical application of classical homeopathy. Students will study key sections of the Organon of Medicine, learn remedy selection, case-taking, and case management, and participate in live case reviews.

Course Format

- Bi-weekly classes
- Students may attend either Wednesday evening or Saturday morning sessions
- Live case taking and case discussions are integrated throughout the course

- Understand the philosophical foundations of homeopathy
- Apply the Law of Similars in clinical situations
- Recognize acute vs. chronic conditions
- Perform basic case-taking and case analysis
- Select and manage remedies safely and effectively
